

OFFICIAL RULES

DRAWING FOR 2010 HARLEY-DAVIDSON ROAD KING® TO BENEFIT THE MARCH OF DIMES FOUNDATION

ELIGIBILITY: OPEN ONLY TO LEGAL RESIDENTS OF THE 50 UNITED STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, 18 years of age and older at the time of entry. Void where prohibited. Employees, Officers and Directors, as well as their immediate family members (parents, children, siblings, spouse) and others living in their same household, whether related or not, of the March of Dimes Foundation (hereafter "The Foundation"), and Worth Harley Davidson North are not eligible to enter.
